
BACKGROUND Why did we make use of WorkCenters?



- Released new admissions platform in October 2013 built within Campus Solutions
- All application data now housed within Campus Solutions including:
 - Transcripts
 - References
 - Supplemental Documents



- Provides all applicant data in single location
- Allows programs to assess and instantly offer admission to applicants



- Developed custom component "Department Assessment" to push application data and decisions through departments
- Front-end of component was standard "Find an Existing Value" functionality
- Created numerous queries end users could run via Query Viewer to support process





ANALYSIS What is a WorkCenter?



- A configurable PeopleSoft page that allows you to combine various existing features
- Consolidate features in PeopleSoft under a core concept or business
- Minimizes the time users spend navigating across the system
- Change the way users interact with the PeopleSoft environment

General Setup



What is a Pagelet?

 Pagelets are small customizable pages that provide snapshots of content from PeopleSoft or non-PeopleSoft applications or websites.

Pagelets in a WorkCenter take many forms:

- My Work Pagelet
- Links Pagelets
- Queries Pagelets




A My Work Pagelet

- A pagelet that presents a series of links to particular pre-defined groupings of items
- User can select to display an active count of matches



A Links Pagelet

 A pagelet that presents a series of links to components within PeopleSoft or elsewhere on the web




A Queries Pagelet

 A pagelet that presents a list of queries that can be run within the WorkCenter






PAGELET #1 (Links)

 Can a WorkCenter connect existing admissions components in one location for users?



PAGELET #2 (Links)

 Can a WorkCenter connect external webbased information related to admissions?




PAGELET #3 (Queries)

 Can a WorkCenter connect all queries available to end users in a single location?



PAGELETS IN ACTION



DYNAMIC REPORTS

- We created some timely dynamic queries designed to push information to users when they enter the WorkCenter
- Reports are set as pagelets to display automatically in the Transaction page as required

QUESTIONS ANSWERED

Recruitment

Who has started an application?

Application Review

- Who has submitted an application and is awaiting assessment?
- Who is ready for a decision?

Matriculation

- Who has accepted an offer?
- Who has conditions that still need to be cleared?

DYNAMIC REPORTS

 Users can select what phase of the admissions process they are focusing on



DYNAMIC REPORTS

- When they enter into the WorkCenter, those reports are automatically available to the user
- Reports use Drilling URLs that connect user to application or email directly

PIVOT TABLES

- Also push automated pivot tables out to users if they choose
- Gives users a graphical statement on application numbers



RESULTS How have things changed?

RESULTS

RELEASE

- First WorkCenter deployed at Western
- Webinars introduced users to the development
- PDFs support the user with instructions

RESULTS

UNINTENDED CONSQUENCES

- SGPS now uses the WorkCenter to manage the pre-assessment of applications
- The reports containing drillable URLs are used by programs to connect with faculty members

RESULTS

END USERS

- User are more comfortable with Admissions data now that it is consolidated in a WorkCenter.
- New applications (particularly ones received during non-peak periods) are less likely to be missed

LESSONS LEARNED

- No amount of documentation/training is too much
- Make sure you have the resources to help people get started with a WorkCenter when you roll it out
- WorkCenters go a long way in making occasional users more comfortable with using PeopleSoft
