- ~40,000 students in 3 careers each year
 - Credit Programs: ~16,000
 - Non-Credit: ~14,400
 - Apprentices: ~9,600
- ~ 1,000 Active Awards

- ~ 8 application periods over 4 terms
 - Historical: In a year: 8,000 students 29,000 apps

PROJECT GOALS


- USE PEOPLESOFT
 We wanted to integrate Scholarship & Bursary processes with student accounts and other features.
- REDUCE MANUAL PROCESSING
 Staff were spending 5 minutes per applicant calculating eligibility, GPA, and financial need.
- IMPROVE THE STUDENT EXPERIENCE
 Students had to search massive award lists and determine their own eligibility.
- ACTIVITY GUIDES
 Collected required information from students efficiently.


Do you want to apply for Scholarships?

Bursaries are awarded to students who have a proven financial need, are maintaining satisfactory academic standing and are enrolled in 60% or more of a full course load.


