- **USE PEOPLESOFT**

We wanted to integrate Scholarship & Bursary processes with student accounts and other features.

- **REDUCE MANUAL PROCESSING**

Staff were spending 5 minutes per applicant calculating eligibility, GPA, and financial need.

- **IMPROVE THE STUDENT EXPERIENCE**

Students had to search massive award lists and determine their own eligibility.

- **ACTIVITY GUIDES**

Collected required information from students efficiently.
