# Real Time Indexing

- Done selectively, required search definitions can be enabled one at a time
- Search definition with Query/Connected Query/Activity Guide as data source can be configured for real-time indexing
- Search definitions with File/Web/External data source are not supported
- Check application rollout schedule

## Prepare for supporting a SaaS SIS

Re-tool and and re-align resources to prepare for differentiation and on-going support of a SaaS application with a continuous delivery model

## Create a data governance plan

Identify how and where data (conversion and transactional) will be owned, transferred, and managed in a SaaS ecosystem

## Create an implementation plan

Identify the project scope and how the implementation will be phased, resourced, and timed to mitigate risk



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
