Why is this so difficult?



A FEW IDEAS

THE BASIC LIGHTBULB



Permission numbers?

- ✗ Still need to verify that they should have permission, and for what, then issue number.
- ✗ All responsibility would land on department assistant.
- ✗ Can only use to permit enrolment in a specific class/section
- ✗ Students would need a new number every time they changed sections.

THE BETTER BULB



Test Scores?

- ✓ Students already do tests
- ✓ Department already marks test and records score
- ✓ Courses already have requisites
- ✓ Would make the information available to other administrators/Registrar's Office
- ✓ Makes self-service add and swap possible

OH, WHY NOT DREAM BIG?



Entry of score could trigger an email telling the student their score in each test!!

GROUNDWORK —JOINT DECISIONS

Which languages?

- Prepare for all four, go live with FRE and SPN

Figure out your testing scale.

- Chose to parallel the language course code progressions
- Special codes for French Immersion, native speakers (who else does department screen?)
- What about multiple tests? Is there a validity period?

Figure out your users

- Who will be able to view/add/update/edit
- Assessor access vs administrator access
- Student service and other viewing?

IRONING OUT THE KINKS



PHASE 1: DEALING WITH REAL STUDENT DATA

WRINKLE 1: Students with upper level placement and no score will still need manual enrolment. Also wanted to keep native speakers out of certain courses



Existing department records were not useful. Did not have ID numbers.

Analyzed grades via pivot table to identify those who needed 601/999 scores

NOW WE'RE ROLLING!

Department began entering scores for new test takers as early as November 2018.

Evaluators enter student score, but are still sending each student notification of results manually. (They are not very excited about this.)

Went live during “2019 Course Intentions” period in March.

Generally, seemed successful. No complaints from Operations Support or Enrolment and Student Records teams about difficulties enrolling.

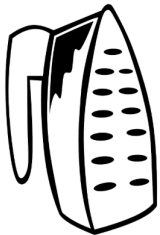

PHASE 1 REVISTED: DEALING WITH REAL STUDENTS

WRINKLE 2: Pre-enrolment numbers for introductory courses are WAY down. Panic ensues.

We did not account for the 'Lazy Factor'. Students had to have a score of 1.00 to enrol in FRE 101 or SPN 101.

Lesson learned: Students are not good at delayed gratification.



Department Chair asked us to remove the test score requirement from FRE 101 and SPN 101.

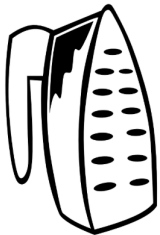
Enrolment numbers improved, but

PHASE 1 RE-REVISTED: DEALING WITH REAL ADMINISTRATORS

WRINKLE 3: SURPRISE (not really), advanced students were enrolling in 101-level courses

Removing the requisite on the introductory courses = everyone can enrol

Yes, EVERYONE, even those with an advanced score



Tried out an enrolment rule of Test Score < 101

PHASE 1 RE-RE-REVISTED: LOGIC'S GONNA GET YOU EVERY TIME

WRINKLE 4: Score < 101 does NOT allow brand new students with no score at all to enrol, which was mostly the point of removing the requisite.

Lesson learned: No test at all and a zero test score are not the same thing.

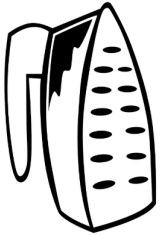


Create empty test score records (i.e.: RU_FRENCH score = zero/blank) for every student by recurring batch job. That's creating a lot of records for a lot of students who will never even attempt to enrol.

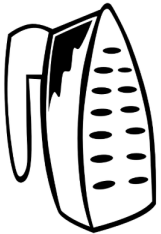


Create a user programmable condition to recognize no score at all as if it were a zero score. This touches COBOL so not happening

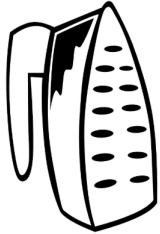
PHASE 1 RE-RE-RE-REVISTED: FAILURE IS NOT AN OPTION



Create a student group to assign to a student whenever a language test score is posted. Incorporate this in the requisite so if you have a test score, it must be 1. If you haven't done the test, you can still enrol.



Rethink: Need separate group for each language, as student may be proficient in French, but have no test/skill in Spanish. So created TFRE, TSPN, TARB, TCHN and set up batch job to run nightly.

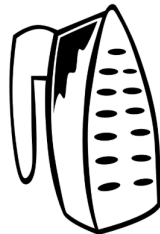

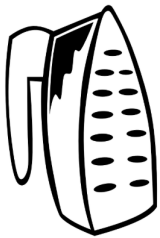

If requisites will be used to keep students with test scores >1 out of intro courses, all existing students need a score/group.

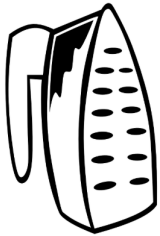


Back to Excel/pivot tables to analyze all graded enrolments in language courses to assign scores.

ANYBODY STILL UNHAPPY?



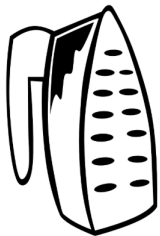
Teaching department must deal with anomalies:

- Some students who do not take the test will be overqualified for 101-level courses
- Some beginners will never bother to take the test
- Some students will enrol in 101 course first, test later, should weed themselves out (but may not).

PHASE 2: AUTOMATIC EMAILS.

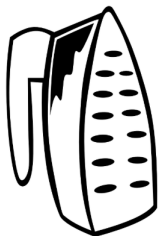
THE DREAM MEETS REALITY

WRINKLE 5: Populating an email with student scores pulled from the Test Results page would require a customization. <sad trombone sound>















Solution: Scale back the dream, and plan for a 'generic email' notifying students that their score has been input, go look at it in SAS

WRINKLE 6: There is no student view of Test Score Summary <sad trombone sound>



Solution: Make one! (Admissions OK with this too.)
CCS set up so DEIN and MATR can view only if "RU_XXXXXX" scores exist (took about a week to sort out)

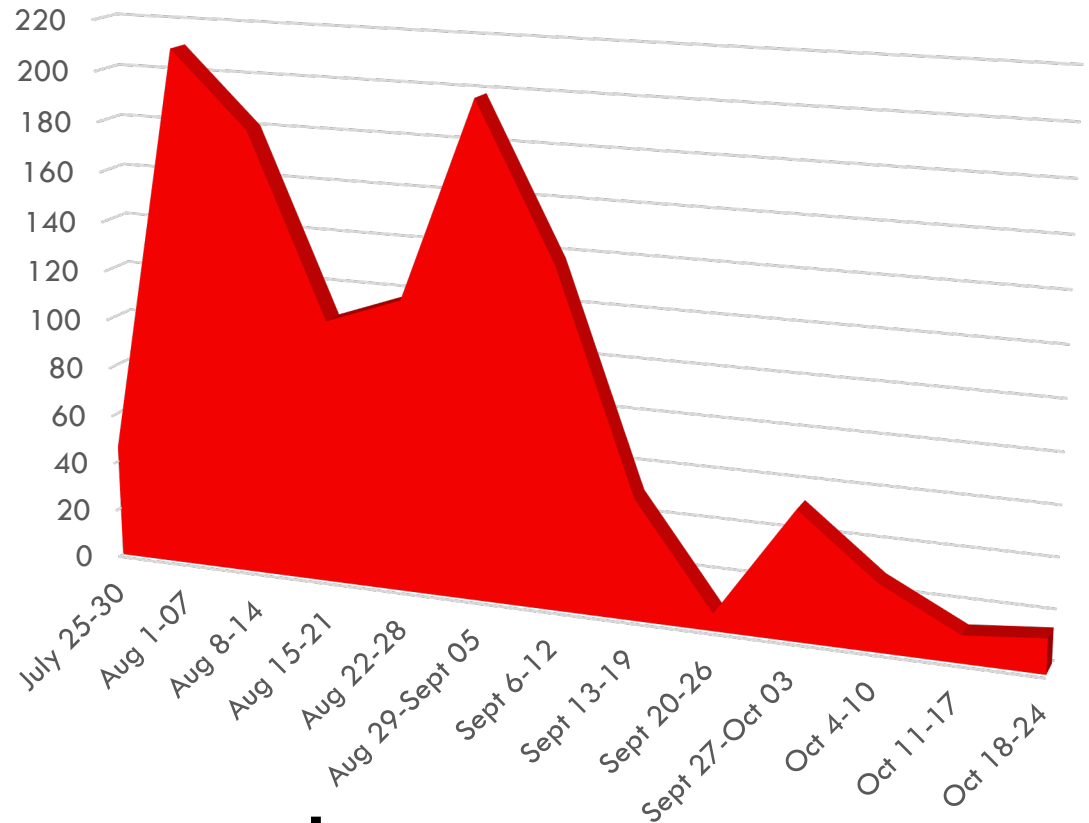

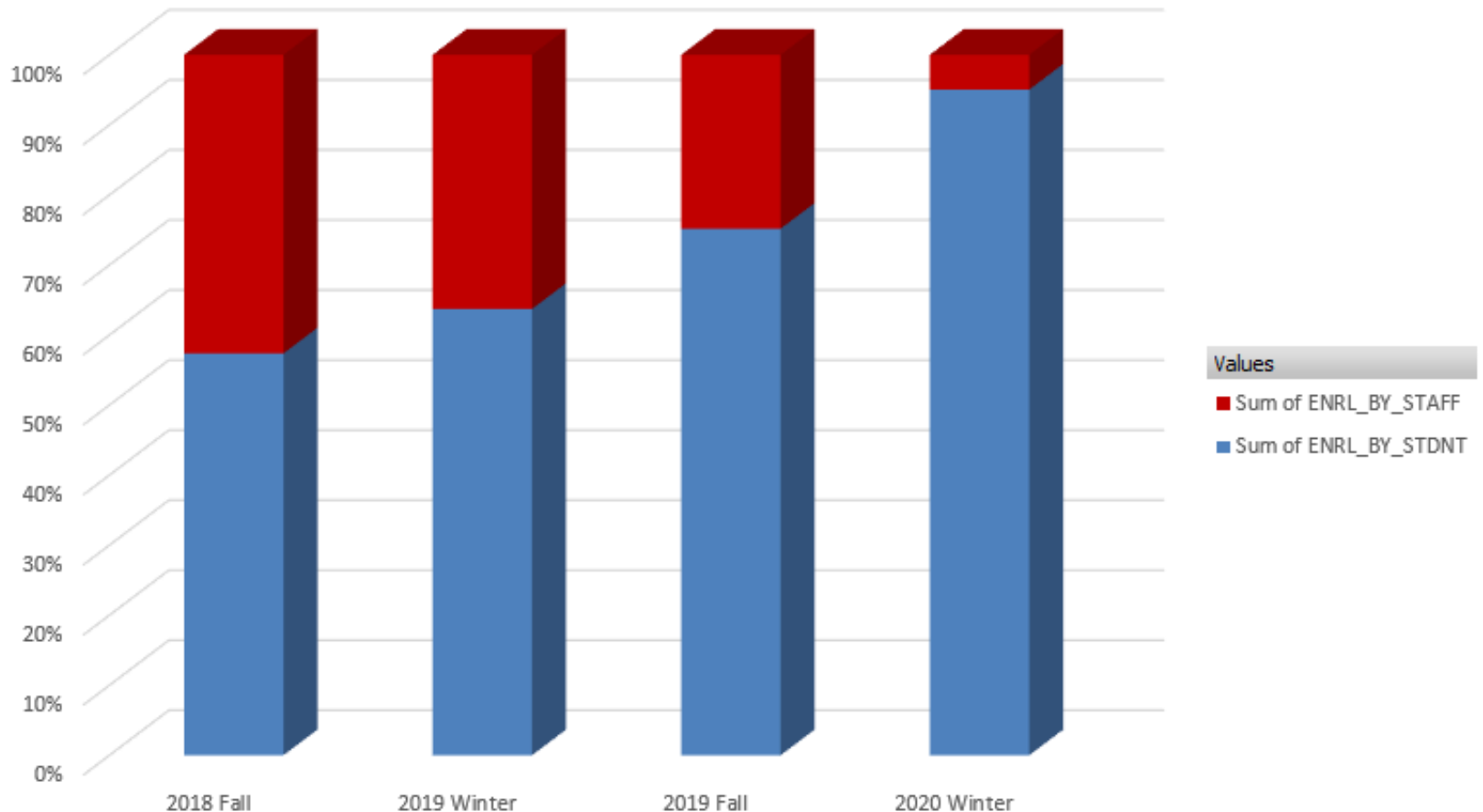
