Data processing for different functions to build the required data marts for Finanace, HR, Revenue, Admission, Procurment,..Etc

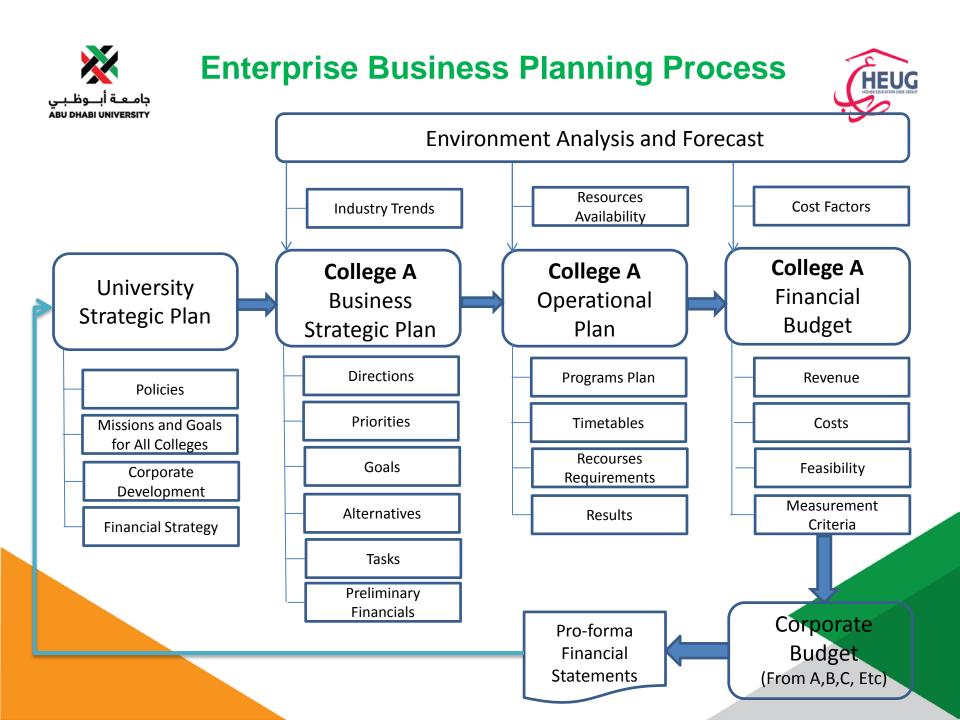
